How important to you are your private times of worship and adoration before the Lord? Do you look forward to coming together on Sundays to praise our wonderful God? This is what Dr. Bill Bright, President of Campus Crusade for Christ International had to say about our "ultimate priority":

"So often we underestimate the importance of praise. Many have the idea that praise is a beautiful aesthetic exercise, but has little practical value. But, if praise is the highest occupation of that great, heavenly, angelic host, there must be some valid reason for it....And there is: Praise is our most powerful weapon in spiritual conflict! Satan is "allergic" to praise, so where there is massive, triumphant praise, Satan is paralyzed, bound, and banished.

When the Lord inhabits the praises of His people, the influence of the enemy is driven away. If our battle is not against flesh and blood, but against the evil rulers of the unseen world (Eph. 6:12), then we need to use powerful, spiritual weapons. Triumphant, overcoming praise is the most effective weapon at our disposal.

Praise which results in constant victory is continuous praise--praise that is a vocation, a way of life. Let us make it our regular practice to arm ourselves for spiritual conflict with a lifestyle of continuous praise."
