ATTENTION: HYMNAL PURISTS

In that we use video projection for song lyrics each week, it did not seem to be a wise expenditure to buy the new Baptist Hymnal when it came out in 2008. But having the 1991 Hymnal in the pew racks week after week can mislead us into thinking that Baptist Hymnody is still in the 90's. Almost every song we have sung for the several months is in the new hymnal. Going back just from June to the present: "Days of Elijah," "Hosanna," "Better is One Day," "Breathe," "How Can I Keep From Singing," "Above All," "Ancient Words," "Lord, I Lift Your Name On High," "Jesus Messiah," "How Deep the Father's Love For Us," "Lord, reign In Me," "How Great is Our God," "I Stand in Awe," "Hear Our Praises," "Trading My Sorrows," "You Are My King (Amazing Love)," "In Christ Alone," "My Savior, My God," "Friend of God," "He Knows My Name," "Draw Me Close," "Come Just As You Are" — all in the new hymnal. What's different about this hymnal is that there is a digital version at Lifewayworship.com where new songs are continually added — essentially a hymnal with "no back cover." Newer songs we are doing, like "Our God," "From the Inside Out," "Our God Saves," "My Savior Lives," "I Will Rise," "Revelation Song," "The Stand," etc. can all be found there.

Unlike Scripture, the hymnal was never intended to be canonized ... it serves as a reminder that, along with the timeless hymns, there will always be a "new song" to sing!
