The tendency would be to just want to sing "Standing On The Promises" like "all the other churches." Problem is: all the other churches aren't singing "Standing On The Promises" anymore. I mentioned Sunday night as we were learning "How He Loves" that it is in the Top 25 CCLI list. This organization, of which we are a paying member, tracks worship song usage in order to pay copyright royalties. With hundreds of thousands member churches, their weekly list gives us a "snapshot" of what the Body of Christ is singing around the world. Here is last week's list:
